UKRAINE-DENMARK ENERGY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME

- UDEPP was established in 2014 following Russia's unprovoked and unjustified attack on Crimea, Donetsk and Luhansk
- Anchored in Ukrainian ministries of energy and restoration/infrastructure, and in the Danish Energy Agency
- Aim is through a government-to-government approach to ensure solutions for an independent and sustainable energy sector in Ukraine
- Balancing short-term energy needs with long-term goals is very difficult in a context of high uncertainty

BUILDING BACK GREENER & MORE RESILIENT

- Donations of Energy Equipment
- Seed financing for the Ukraine Energy Support Fund – now 400+ million EUR pledged
- Urgent Technology Catalogue to support winterisation of Ukrainian power sector
- Development of a national heat roadmap
- Stimulate private investments with loans and guarantees to overcome the risks
- Implementation of EU regulation on energy efficiency and transparent power markets
- Special responsibility for Mykolaiv will be window for showing how to leap-frog into sustainability and climate neutrality
